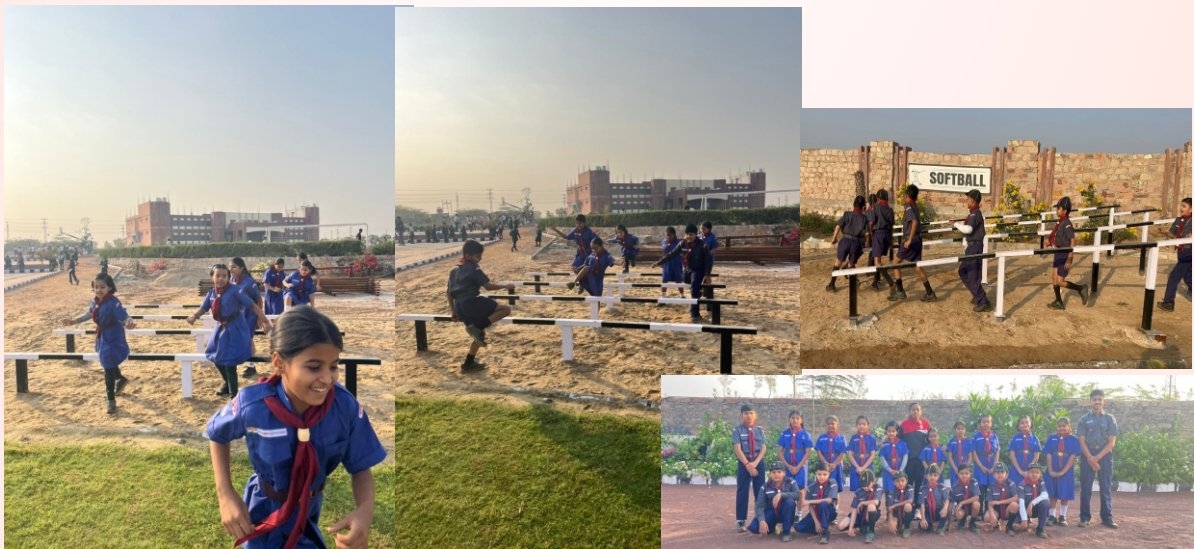
Learning from the Legends : Meeting with Ravi Bishnoi

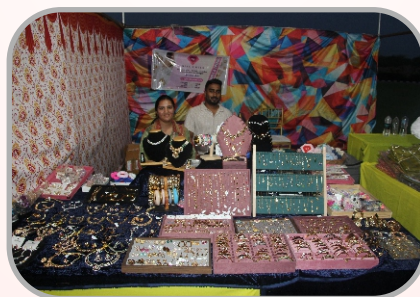


Tiny Tasks, Growing Independence: Itsy Bitsy Activity – PP Section
