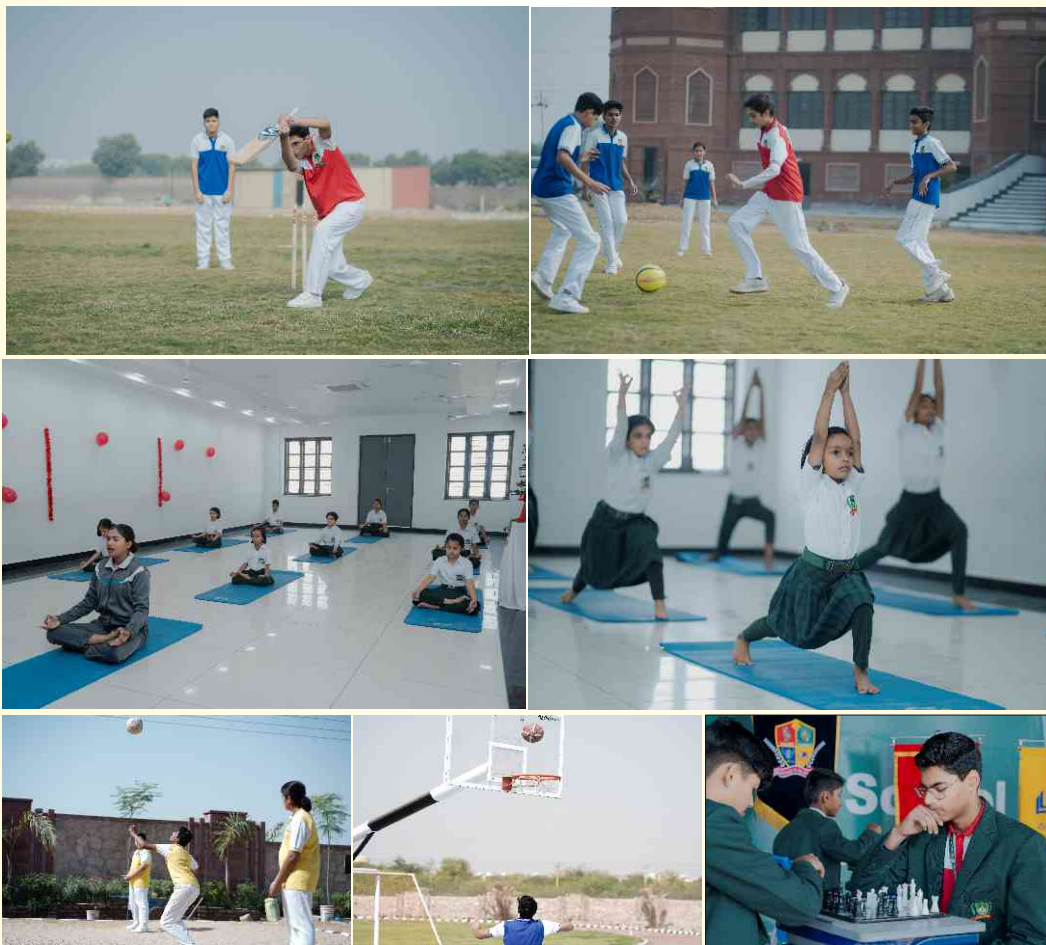
MORNING SPECIALISED SPORTS PROGRAMME
